

POSITION DESCRIPTION – Herbarium Curator

Position Title: Herbarium Curator Level: 5

Faculty/Division: Science Department/Location: Biological Sciences

Primary purpose of the position:

The Janet Cosh Herbarium is part of the School of Biological Sciences and consists of a regionally significant plant collection, botanical illustrations repository and library. The Herbarium requires a curator to maintain and develop the collection, provide support for teaching and research and facilitate activities which connect with other institutions and the broader community.

Position Environment: (Optional)

The position will contribute to the School of Biological sciences by facilitating undergraduate teaching and research being undertaken by academic staff and postgraduate students. The herbarium and the activities of the herbarium staff enhance the connection with the wider community by providing an important resource for the identification of plants in the region.

Special Job Requirements:


